Admission Process

For Domestic Students

The process in transferring into Adams College of English is very convenient and efficient. Our welcoming staff will be happy to assist you and guide you through it. We recommend visiting ACE's campus in order to apply and proceed on with the transfer process. For your visit, please prepare and bring the following documentation:

- Application (printable online or you may apply online at www.adamscollege.edu)
- Application fee \$100 (one-time fee, non-refundable)
- Passport, F-1 visa, I-94
- I-20 from your current school
- Bank statement of at least \$4,000 which is no more than 3 months old
- Transfer Release Form (obtainable online or on campus)
- Tuition fee for the length you are planning to attend

After ACE has received all required documentation, we will send an Acceptance Letter to your current school and ask for you to be released. Please make sure you have submitted and signed all required documentation at your current school so that you may be transferred out in the SEVIS system successfully.

For Overseas Students

The process in obtaining your F-1 visa from your country is simple. Here are the documents ACE needs in order to proceed onto your next step:

- Application (printable online or you may apply online at www.adamscollege.edu)
- Application fee \$200 (one-time fee, non-refundable)
- Passport
- Bank statement of at least \$16,000 which is no more than 3 months old
- Initial fees: \$200 Tuition Deposit and \$50 Mailing Fee (non-refundable)
- SEVIS I-901 fee: \$200 (this fee is for SEVP and can be paid online. If you need assistance, please notify the school.)

After ACE has received all required documentation, we will send you your I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility for F-1) and Acceptance Letter. Once you have received your I-20, you must make an appointment with your country's Embassy or Consulate for an in-person visa interview. All applicants have up to thirty (30) days before the first day of school to enter the United States. Once the student has entered the United States, the student must contact the school and schedule an appointment to take the placement test and receive orientation.
